

## **Residential Support Supervisor**

- Previous experience working with individuals with cognitive and/or physical challenges or previous experience in a human service setting serving vulnerable populations would be considered an asset;
- Previous supervisory experience would be considered an asset;
- Strong communication skills;
- Flexible to adjust to last minute changes to work schedule and the ability to accept and embrace change in day-to-day operations;
- Exhibit a high degree of initiative and drive;
- Able to multi-task and work in a high-stress, fast-paced environment;
- Effective critical thinking and decision making skills;
- Proficient computer skills in Microsoft Word, Excel and Outlook;
- Must provide a clear Criminal Record Check Vulnerable and a clear Driver's Abstract.
