- Create and uphold an atmosphere of warmth, patience, enthusiasm in a calm and cheerful environment;
- Maintain and promote the wellbeing, uniqueness and independence of each client;
- Assist in the development and monitoring of client case plans, as required;
- Complete and maintain required documentation;
- Collaborate with Community Support Workers and Residential Support Workers and communicate changes in the clients' condition;
- Assist clients with physical therapy exercises in collaboration with Community Support Workers and Residential Support Workers;
- Take actions to maintain a safe and clean environment.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Minimum of a College diploma in Human Services, or RCW/LPN;
- Previous experience working with individuals with cognitive and/or physical challenges or previous experience in a human service setting serving vulnerable populations would be considered an asset;
- Possess critical thinking and decision-making skills;
- A team player with excellent attendance;
- Ability to multi-task and work in a fast-paced environment;
- Excellent oral and written communication skills;
- Ability to work independently and under minimal supervision.
- A clear Criminal Record Check Vulnerable and a clear Driver's Abstract
- Valid CPR and First Aid Certificates (must be maintained during employment);
- Valid driver's license and access to a personal vehicle during working hours (must be maintained during employment);
